- <u>Drop-in Play/Stay & Play/Free Play/Play, Learn, & Connect</u>: Children participate in interactive play activities & parents connect with other parents/caregivers & Parent Coaches. Parenting & child development information & resources available.
- Coffee Q & A/Coffee & Chatter: Children participate in interactive, imaginative play while
 parents enjoy meeting other parents/caregivers & interact with staff on questions about
 development, behavior, parenting & resources.
- <u>Baby Talk</u>: Join other parents and babies up to 12 months to socialize & learn about relevant topics concerning parenting an infant; program offered in partnership with the Strathmore Health Unit. *Older siblings Welcome!*
- <u>Preschool Talk Time:</u> Drop-in play! A Preschool Speech Therapist will be on site for any
 questions you might have about your child's speech & sensory development.
- <u>Stroller Walk:</u> Meet at the South end of Kinsmen Park, by the splash park, for a walk and to play afterwards at the playground. Come burn off some energy! *In the event of inclement weather Parent Link Centre Playroom will be open!*
- <u>Play In The Park:</u> (All Ages) Meet at the North parking lot of Kinsmen Park. Dress appropriately for the weather. In the event of inclement weather, the Parent Link Centre Playroom will be open!
- <u>Groovy Grandparents:</u> Drop-In Playtime for Grandparents & Kids. Coffee & tea provided. No registration required!
- <u>Triple P Discussion Groups:</u> Come for 1 or all 4 of these great parenting topics. Kids play
 while parents/caregivers are learning how to manage their child's behavior. These sessions
 are held in our playroom & resource materials are provided. *Must Register.*
